Dear Parents:

The 1994 session of the General Assembly amended the Code of Virginia to require each division superintendent to prepare and distribute the estimated average per pupil cost for public education in the division for the coming school year, as well as actual per pupil expenditures for the previous school year. This notice is to be provided to each parent, guardian, or other person having control or charge of a child enrolled in the division.
